Since its founding in 1978, the Study Center has taught more than 1000 courses to more than 10,000 students. In the past two years, the JSC has grown significantly, opening four new venues for classes, hiring a new Executive Director, moving into a new office, creating a new website, and, most importantly, adding new students and teachers.

Our vibrant and innovative program varies each season, with 18-20 different classes offered in five locations, three semesters per year. The energetic exchange of ideas is strengthened by the diversity of the students, who are of all ages and backgrounds.



We are busy strengthening our program in Washington by planning new programs, times, and locations for classes, and expanding into more of the D.C. Metro area, including Northern Virginia. The recent report from the Jewish Outreach Institute cited the JSC as one of the organizations most active in reaching out to the non-affiliated Jewish population of Washington. There are more than 60,000 Jews in the D.C. Metro area and our mailing list keeps growing.

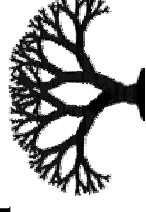
